A long mountain gravel loop intended to be completed in two stages. On the first day, the route goes from Biel to Undués de Lerda across the Sierra de Santo Domingo, through the Fayanas and Lucientes mounts, from south to north towards Longás. Then, the route ascends to the Javierre mountain and descends through a track (be careful there!), until it reaches the quiet road that crosses Bal de Onsella from east to west, passing through Bagues, Los Pintanos, and Undués-Pintano. After Undués-Pintano, the route follows a track to Ruesta (an optional visit, but that we recommend) which connects with the Camino de Santiago and the final stretch of the local road heading towards Undués de Lerda, where both the bar and the hostel owners love gravel and bikes.

On the second day, the route runs along good local roads and rural tracks heading to Urriés, Bavadún, and Petilla de Aragón, in the Bal de Onsella. Then, there is a climb to Portillo de Sibirana through a forest track, followed by a descent (be careful: this is the first stretch in poor conditions) towards the magical Castle of Sibirana and Pozo Pígallo, on the south side of the Sierra de Santo Domingo. The route follows a track to Luesia and continues down the road that will lead you back to Biel.
