Los Pintanos

A beautiful and panoramic route for mountain bikes that takes place mostly along tracks, with a few stretches of road, at the heart of the Bal de Onsella valley.

The route starts in the village of Los Pintanos, follows a stretch of road, and then climbs a track that ventures into an oak forest until it reaches the peak of the Sarda hill. Then, it continues along the crest toward the **Cuatro Caminos pass**, passing by the Magdalena hermitage, where you can enjoy amazing panoramic views of the Pyrenees. Before reaching the pass, there is a stretch of road followed by a track that goes down toward Ruesta and connects with the **Camino de Santiago (St. Jame's Path)**. This stretch offers beautiful views of the Yesa reservoir and the Sierra de Leyre range.

The route reaches the access road to Ruesta (we recommend visiting the town), crosses the road, and climbs the Regal river toward the village of **Undúes Pintano**. This stretch offers nice views of the pools in the river. Once you reach Undúes Pintano, you will take the road for 2 km until you reach the starting point in **Los Pintanos**.
