**Uncastillo and Sádaba**

This route is a perfect combination of mountain gravel and steppe, joining the Sierra de Santo Domingo and the Bardenas Reales nature park.

This challenging route, which starts in Uncastillo, follows the road heading to Luesia and continues along the forest tracks of Sierra de Santo Domingo towards Pozo Pígal and the Castle of Sibirana. Then, the route ascends until it reaches the top of the Portillo de Baztanes, following the crest of a wind farm with spectacular sights of the Pyrenees. A local road connects the summit with Mamillas and Sofuentes, and then the route takes you to Figarol along rural tracks.

After Figarol, the route ventures into the Bardenas Reales nature park, in Navarra, to follow a spectacular stretch across the steppe and impossible sandstone formations. The route exits the park through the military barrack (there might be access restrictions) towards Pinsoro. After Pinsoro, the route follows a road and a rural track towards Sádaba, and then continues to Layana, passing the amazing Roman site of Bañales. The route continues along rural tracks heading towards Biota, where you take a local road uphill to Malpica de Arba, before reaching the end of the route back in Uncastillo.
