Luna

A classic cycle tour of the Cinco Villas district that replicates the path of the famous Marcha Cicloturista de Monlora (Monlora Bike Ride).

The route starts in the village of Luna and you head towards Valpalmas, Piedratajada, and Puendeluna, riding on local roads with continuous steep slopes, surrounded by a steppe and farmland that brings the Wild West to mind.

You pass through Ardisa and after crossing the bridge over the River Gállego, you start a climb that doesn't end until you reach the village of Ayerbe.

In Ayerbe, the route descends again to the iron bridge over the Gállego, which marks the start of the Sierra Mayor mountain pass, going through Santa Eulalia de Gállego. The ascent is constant and winds through pine tree woods. When you reach the top of the Sierra Mayor mountain pass, the route descends to Fuencalderas and Biel, with a few steep slopes in between.

Once you have arrived in Biel, the route continues descending to the south until you reach the villages of El Frago and then Luna. It is a peaceful path in the shade.

In Luna, you can take the path to the Santuario de Monlora, on a small mountain pass but with demanding slopes. When you reach the top, the prize is the beautiful panoramic views of the Cinco Villas and the Pyrenees.
