Biota

Another route of pure slow cycling pleasure that takes you into the depths of the middle area of the Cinco Villas. You will visit the picturesque village of Malpica de Arba, riding on local roads with hardly any traffic, so you can enjoy each pedal stroke while appreciating the landscape.

The route starts in Biota and heads north to Malpica de Arba, climbing the small Alto de Biota mountain pass. From Malpica it descends to the River Arba de Luesia and, after crossing it, there is another ascent to the Devil's Fountain, from where you quickly descend to then pedal up a steep slope that takes you to the mediaeval village of Uncastillo.

From this village, first you have to go up a hill, the Collado de Itorre, then you have a short descent before going uphill again to another village of a marked mediaeval character: Luesia.

After leaving the village of Luesia, the route progressively descends next to the bank of the River Agonía, passing through Asín and Farasdués.

When you reach this village, you continue in the direction of Ejea, although after four kilometres, you must divert to the right on an asphalted service track that borders the head of the Embalse (Reservoir) of San Bartolomé and then continues to the starting point of the route in Biota.
